Ian Fleming authored 14 novels. Fans Albert Broccoli and Harry Saltzman created Eon Productions (financed via United Artists), snapped up rights to all but two scripts, shot **25 ICONIC BOND FLICKS**.

- 1 "___" (1962, Sean) British agent Strangways mice-demised in Jamaica. Bond dispatched, follows trail to Cayman fisher Quarrel, who reports of Strangway's mineral forays to Crab Key, home to nefarious recluse. Quarrel lands Bond on island, ashore strides bikinied shell diver Honey Ryder (Ursula Andress). After Quarrel is charcoaled by Fire-Breathing-Tractor, Bond and Honey captured. Dr. No elucidates on acronym SPECTRE: **SP**ecial **E**xecutive for **C**ounter-intelligence, **T**errorism, **R**evenge, and **E**xortion. Dr. No's vision: redirect Project Mercury space launch from Florida with atomic powered radio beam. Bond escapes, garbs goon-garb, cranks up "Danger Level" knob to full, clobbers would-be correctors. Dr. No with face-shield grapples with Bond, in close proximity of boiling something. Dr. No succumbs. Bond decrews motor boat, crews Honey, throttles...explosions. On US cutter, Jack Lord, "Help?" "No."
- 2 "___" (1989, Timothy) Enroute to Felix's wedding, he and Bond are choppered to nearby air field to arrest drug dealer Sanchez, who takes off in small plane. Suspended from cable, Bond hooks tail and harnesses Sanchez. Then Felix and James make grand entrance, parachute to wedding, where bride Della and Leiter present Bond with engraved silver lighter. Sanchez later escapes, kills new bride, maims Felix. Bond vows revenge, ignores call to return to duty, M revokes his license. In the Republic of Isthmus, Bond infiltrates Sanchez's drug refinery, captured, briefed on plot to sell for \$100 million four tankers of cocaine-dissolved, recoverable gasoline mix. Bond meets pilot Bouvier (Carey Lowell). Villain Dario (young Benicio del Toro) prods Bond into a shredder, Bouvier arrives, shoots, shreds Dario. Scantly-dressed Bouvier swoops plane upon convoy of four tankers, Bond drops in. Bond extinguishes a driver, runs a fellow tanker off the road, jacks truck on left wheels to avoid incoming missile, missile hits crashed tanker, explosion. His jack-knifed rig leaves his tank jutting over cliff, Bond times it and releases tank, it careens below to hit lead tanker. Leaps into tankless cab, chases remaining tanker, leaps aboard. Tussle, Sanchez gets doused in gas, tanker crashes. Bond, Sanchez tossed about: Sanchez with machete, Bond with Leiter's lighter...Sanchez-flambe, explosion. Bouvier in Bond's tankless truck gives Bond a lift.
- 3 "From ___ With Love" (1963, Sean) SPECTRE devises a plot to steal a Lektor cryptograph from Russia, sell it back to Russia, meanwhile exacting revenge on Bond for Dr. No. Operative Rosa Klebb assigned command, recruits assassin Donald "Red" Grant (Robert Shaw), and attractive Tatiana Romanova, a cipher clerk at Soviet consulate in Istanbul, as unwitting bait. Bond travels to Turkey, meets MI-6's Kerim Bey, meets adoring Tatiana, and the three manage to escape with device on the Orient Express. Grant assumes an MI-6's identity, strangles Kerim, meets Bond, drugs Tatiana, but errs on wine choice. Bond, Grant face-off in cabin. Grant with upper hand, tricked into opening attache, tear gas, a vicious melee, Grant extends wristwatch wire. Bond springs knife from attache, uses wire garrot on Red Grant. James and Tatiana escape with Lektor to Venice. Disguised as hotel maid, Klebb attempts to retrieve Lektor, Tatiana bats Klebb's gun. Klebb with toe knife, Bond with chair, Tatiana with bullet into Klebb.
- 5 "___" (1964, Sean) Sicced onto bullion dealer Auric, 007 busts him cheating at rummy in Miami, seduces accomplice Jill, gets her asphyxiated by way of Odd all-body gold paint Job. At golf club, lurking 007 and Auric paired due to coincidental handicaps, gamble, both cheat. Bond slips GPS on Phantom 337 Rolls Royce while awaiting "Golf"inger's losing gambling check. Bond GPS leads to Switzerland factory, observes dismantling of the 30 or so gold parts mostly comprising the Rolls Royce. Bond 007 captured,

generously briefed, released. Observes Goldfinger's treacherous gassing of Mafiosi-gangster financiers. Recaptured, rebriefed, re-released. Bond infiltrates, seduces one Pussy Galore, Goldfinger's head-pilot. Sexy co-fliers, Galore deadly crop-dust Fort Knox Army. GI's "go on", Goldfinger's goons go on...for gold. Having feigned death, soldiers erupt with machine-gun bursts, bursts returned, those in turn returned. Alone in the vault room, Oddjob whisks deadly metal-bladed hat, nips electrical wire. Bond whisks back, hat imbedded in metal bars. Oddjob commences to amusedly batter 007 about, reaches to retrieve killing hat. Bond "slides into second", scoops the wire and stabs the bars...electrocution. "Shocking." Felix congratulates, sends Bond to awaiting jet, bound for presidential thanks. Pouncing from cockpit, Goldfinger hoists a golden gun, Bond deflects aside, grapples, stray shot blows window, vacuum roars. Goldfinger pops out seemingly-too-small window, Bond climbs to the cockpit, joins kidnapped Galore. "Where's Goldfinger?" "Playing his Golden Harp." Controls jammed, James and Pussy parachute down. Felix conducts chopper search. Near parachute, Pussy Galore jumps, waves, but Bond pulls her down. "Oh no you don't. This is no time to be rescued." Bond snogs her, enwraps them in privacy parachute.

7 "___" (1965, Sean) Bond is sent to Bahamas to investigate SPECTRE's hijacking of two atomic bombs. Aided by CIA Felix, Bond suspects playboy Emilio Largo, surveys yacht. Largo harpooned, bombs retrieved. [Sean's last Bond was non-Eon production "Never Say Never Again", which is a remake of this dud.]

8 As Jaws bear-hugs Bond, Bond to M on speaker phone, "Later Sir. Right now, ___ bit of a tight spot."

9 "You Only ___" (1967, Sean) Bond assigned to Japan to look into spacecraft theft by another spacecraft. With Intel-Agent Tanaka, Bond discovers SPECTRE's Ernst Blofeld (Donald Pleasence) plot to start WWII by directing earlier-hijacked American spacecraft into attacking a Soviet one. Bikinied Kissy and James explore island spaceport covered by a fake lake. Bond assumes astronaut garb to thwart plot, but Ernst spies him, captures 007. "I thought you were assassinated in Hong Kong." "Yes, this is my second life." Cradling fat white cat, Blofeld gloats as American spacecraft launches, incomprehendingly allows Bond to smoke a trick cigarette, which shoots a villain. Bond karate chops another dozen, levers open "lake". Tanaka's ninja troops slide down ropes, open fire, take control. Blofeld escapes for another movie. As American spacecraft bears down on Soviets, Bond attacks Lieutenant, pick-pockets deactivation key, flips him off walkway into piranha pool. "Bon appetite." With US and USSR bombers aloft, Bond keys self-destruct button for attacking spacecraft, kablooe! Five seconds to spare, combatants stand-down.

12 "On Her ___ Secret Service" (1969, Lazenby) On the scent of Blofeld, Bond rescues Tracy di Vincenzo (Diana Rigg) from suicide drowning, remeet later in casino. Her syndicate father Draco leads Bond to Swiss solicitor. Break-in there reveals Blofeld established an allergy research institute atop Piz Gloria in the Swiss Alp, its true mission being to brainwash attractive women patients into distributing bacteriological warfare agents to various parts of the world. Bond escapes clinic, leads raid with Draco's men. Blofeld again escapes. Bond marries Tracy, who's shot in drive-by by Blofeld's partner, Irma Bunt.

13 "___ Are Forever" (1971, Sean) Bond sent to Amsterdam to investigate diamond smuggling, starting in Africa, ending in USA. Posing as smuggler Franks, Bond meets Tiffany Case (Jill St. John), receives diamonds, travels to USA to meet CIA Felix Leiter. Trail leads to Las Vegas casino-hotel owned by

Willard Whyte (Jimmy Dean). Various "interviews" lead to a Whyte research laboratory, home to a diamond-enhanced laser satellite capable of igniting nuclear bombs in their silos. Auction sale to the highest bidder, informs Blofeld after Bond's capture [does he never not get captured?]. Bond escapes moon movie set in buggy. Then Bond, Tiffany hop into 1971 Mustang Mach 1. Vegas cops give chase. Bond pops car on two wheels, shimmies through narrow alley, escapes. Bond scales casino, tussles with female bodyguards Bambi and Thumper, frees Whyte, discover Blofeld's base is offshore oil rig. Bond sneaks onto rig, captured yet again as Blofeld trains the satellite on Washington DC. Signalled, helicopter army attacks. Bond takes control of crane suspending Blofeld in escape pod, bangs Ernst about and destroys the control room, timely disrupts satellite. Explosions, dives off rig with Tiffany. Compliments of Whyte, Bond and Tiffany are relaxing on a yacht, when killers Mr. Wint and Mr. Kid enter with catered feast, serve. Bond recognizes Kid's aftershave, inflames Wint, dessert-bombs Kid. "Now, what was your question?" Tiffany purrs, "How the hell do we get those diamonds down?"

- 14 "Tomorrow __ Dies" (1997, Pierce) Bond investigates the sinking of a British warship in Chinese waters, the theft of ship's cruise missile, and the downing of a Chinese fight jet. Chinese agent Wai Lin pairs with Bond, who discover that media mogul Elliot Carver (Jonathan Pryce) used a GPS encoder to divert the British ship into Chinese waters, hoping to start a war...always good for media. With British fleet enroute to Beijing, Bond and Wai Lin board Carver's stealth ship, disable "invisibilty cloak", allowing British military to locate and attack vessel. With British cruise missile set to hit Beijing, Carver gloats of his success over beat-up Bond, who taps a switch, activating a super-grinder, grinds Carver. Bond disrupts signal and Wai Lin, Bond take quick refuge underwater, explosion...necking. [Wai Lin is portrayed by Michelle Yeoh.]
- 15 "Live And __" (1973, Roger) Bond investigates murders of three MI-6 agents, discovers all were on the scent of one Dr. Kananga, dictator of San Monique. After Whisper drive-by murder attempt, plates lead to New Orleans restaurant chain Fillet of Soul, where Bond is neatly captured by a swivelling wall. American gangster Mr. Big sends Bond with his mechanic-armed Tee Hee to The Farm, a local heroine factory. Bond is islanded with crocs, escapes across backs, flees via exciting boat chase. Trail leads to San Monique, where Bond seduces Solitaire, Dr. Kananga's seer, via card trick. He's captured again! Mr. Big reveals himself as Dr. Kananga, divulges plot to give away two tons of heroine thru Fillet of Soul, run competitors into bankruptsy, sharply increase addicts, sharply increase prices. Bond and Solitaire suspended over shark tank, Bond attracts air-compressed shark bullet with magnetized watch, same watch power-saws restraining rope. Kicks Whisper into restraint, fights Kananga, they both fall in pool. James forces air-compressed bullet into Kananga's mouth, who explodes like an over-inflated balloon. Solitaire, Bond recuperate in train cabin when Tee Hee attacks Bond, who snips arm wire, tosses him. Bond snaps open flip-bed where Solitaire (Jane Seymour) was earlier pinned. Cooing, they make-out.
- 16 Initials of weed-dispensary fave, presumably derived from "Original Gangsters"
- 17 "The Man With The __" (1974, Roger) Bond sent on a mission to locate missing British scientist Gibson who invented the "Solex Agitator", a solar device to solve energy crisis. After Gibson killed and device stolen, M dispatches Bond to retrieve Agitator and kill assassin Francisco Scaramanga (Christopher Lee). Aided by golden bullet inscribed with "007", Bond tracks Scaramanga to Hong Kong isle. Refereed by Nick Nack (Herve Villechaize, "Fantasy Island"), Bond out-duels Scaramanga by mimicking a mannequin.

- 19 "___eye" (1995, Pierce) In 1986 Russia, 007 and 006 break into weapons facility, plant bombs, 006 executed by Soviet Colonel Ourumov. Bond planes out, explosions. Nine years...Bond tries, fails to thwart hijacking of prototype "Eurocopter Tiger", made to withstand electromagnetic pulses. Sadistic albeit comely Xenia Onatopp pilots Ourumov to Soviet HQ housing satellite electromagnetic weapons. Ourumov slings authority around, Onatopp slings bullets around. The pair secure the crucial Goldeneye program disk, after directing satellite laser to destroy facility as they chopper out. Comely survivor Natalya Simonova (Izabella Scorupco) is thermo-spotted by Bond, enlisted. Pair uncover 006's faked demise and trio's plot to sneak millions from Bank of England, train Goldeneye to laser it, cover tracks. After requisite capture, Bond introduced to other "survivor", tech geek Boris, who thrice clicks Bond's exploding pen. Bond, Natalya flee. Boris survives blast and fixes Natalya's Goldeneye reprogramming. Bond scuffles with last of Bond-demised trio, ex-agent Trevelyan 006 (Sean Bean, "Boromir"). At base of ladder perched atop colossal Goldeneye satellite dish, Bond in trouble, switch, 006 in worse trouble. "For England, James?" Bond releases his foot hold on 006, "No, for me." Natalya pilots chopper, Bond dives to strut. Fallen, stunned 006 engulfed by impaling tower, requisite explosions. Beam disrupted.

- 45 "___ Another Day" (2002, Pierce) Bond dispatched to disrupt diamonds-for-weapons op headed by North Korean Colonel Tan-Sun Moon. In ensuing hovercraft chase, Moon's craft plunges over waterfall. Bond captured and tortured for 14 months, traded to Britain in exchange for Moon's henchman Zao. Despite suspension, Bond tracks Zao to a gene appearance-altering clinic. Zao then leads Bond to British billionaire Gustav Graves, who unveils a mirror satellite called "Icarus", ostensibly to provide year-round sunshine for crop development. Bond discovers Graves is gene-altered Colonel Moon and his plot is to use "Icarus" as a "sun gun" to cut path through Demilitarized Zone, forcibly reunite Korea. CIA's Jinx (Halle Berry) joins Bond on Gustav's central-control jet. Jinx spars, knifes Lieutenant. Bond, Moon in man-to-man, all this while "Icarus" is burning a wide swath through Korea. Graves is apparelled in a kind of Robo-Cop suit and upper-hands Bond. By now, jet is shot-up, exposed, so Bond rips Gustav's chute and Gustav exits into jet turbine. Bond cuts beam, missile destroys "Icarus". Bond and Jinx neck.

- 58 "The ___ Enough" (1999, Pierce) A British oil tycoon and friend to M is killed with poisoned money, which Bond traces to Renard (Robert Carlyle), a KGB agent turned-terrorist who had previously kidnapped tycoon's daughter, Elektra. To avoid repeat, Bond assigned to protect her. On the ski slopes Bond and Elektra are beset by armed motorized hang-gliders, all of whom Bond handily dispatches. A tip here, a kill there, Bond follows trail to Russian ICBM base in Kazakhstan, where Bond meets nuclear scientist Dr. Christmas (Denise Richards). Pair uncover Stockholm-thing between Renard and Elektra, who intend to create a nuclear explosion aboard submarine parked in Istanbul to increase the value of Elektra's pipeline. Elektra kidnaps M, Bond frees M, calmly caps bullet in Elektra's forehead. Renard is next, as Dr. Christmas and Bond grapple with him in submarine's missile-silo room. Renard beats on Bond, loads nuclear rod into chamber. Bond infuses chamber with pressure hose, rod device rockets out chamber, impaling Renard. A lesser explosion imminent, Bond, Christmas escape through torpedo hatch, passing tourist boat picks them up. MI-6 crew locate two tightly-bound heat signatures.

Bond thwarts Le Chiffre's practice of shorting stock, then sabotaging those companies, as Bond tussles aboard fuel tanker set to ram maiden voyage of prototype jetliner. Bond slide-brakes rig within inches. Under pressure, Le Chiffre hosts 10 mill-buy-in poker tourney, winner take-all, in Montenegro casino. Brit treasury agent Vesper in charge of oversight disses, dismisses Bond, even decides on Bond's suit! In tournament's early stages, Bond fares better than most. Gambler CIA Felix Leiter introduces himself and invests in better-bet Bond to break Le Chiffre, who'll sing if financially cornered. After tossing Nambutu agents about and surviving disagreeable martini, Bond goes all in, narrowly defeats Le Chiffre. Le Chiffre kidnaps Vesper, car-flips chasing Bond, tortures Bond for money code, eats Mr. White bullet. In Venice, Bond falls for Vesper, Vesper absconds funds. 007 pursues her to boss Mr. White, shoot-out, Vesper drowned in collapsing canal building. M explains the exchange Vesper crafted for Bond's life. Mr. White drives onto palatial estate, takes call, "Mr. White?" Rifle snip snips his leg. "Name's Bond..." (Vesper is portrayed by Eva Green.)

- 26 "For Your Eyes ___" (1985, Roger) After British spy boat sinks, Bond ordered to retrieve Automatic Targeting Attack Communicator. In Italy, uncovers businessman Aris Kristatos, hooks up with father-killed Melina (Carole Bouquet). Pair hunt down Kristatos and beat up his lieutenants. As Melina about to crossbow him, Kristatos knifed in back by loyal companion to Melina's late father.
- 28 "The ___ Daylights" (1987, Timothy) Three 00's parachute to Brit base for war-games exercise, enemy agent ignores paint-balls, kills GI's and two 00's. Bond wrestles him while driving over cliff, Bond yanks back-up chute, thrust out back of vehicle, as same vehicle, driver succumb to awaiting ocean. Opening song intrudes on relevance, jump to Bond defecting General Koskov, Bond searching through rifle scope for snipers, spies an unprofessional. Cellist Kara fires shot, Bond returns chip off her rifle. Koskov defects. Bond later muses, "Whoever she was, I must've scared the living daylights out of her." In a chopper, Soviets "recapture" Koskov, who staged defection with ex-girl friend Kara. Bond unearths associated arms dealer Brad Whitaker (Joe Don Baker). Embroiled in high-speed snow chase, Bond wreaks havoc and wrecks Martin. Kara, Bond transfer to cello case, bullets fly, slide into Switzerland. The villainous plot: embezzle KGB funds, purchase diamonds, then drugs. Bond and Kara escape on plane loaded with drugs...and overly-efficient chizeled Soviet blond thug. Bond boots blond and drugs. Liberated Kamran Shah, squad celebrate as Bond drops explosives on Indian bridge, severing Soviets. Ascertaining certain crash, Bond, Kara hasten to jeep, reverse off rear ramp, bounce, skid. "Dinner?" Bond faces Whitaker, Whitaker cannon-fires from Civil War model. Bond's cohorts rush in, riddle villain.

Revealed plot: exchange armaments to destroy Moscow, New York, thus starting war, better civilization. Bond escapes, frees submariners, pursues Stromberg, who has Anya, to his headquarters, a wondrous spider-like sea-craft, with palatial main room. Stromberg is seated at very long table, invites armed Bond to sit, fires an underneath gun with barrel the length of table. Bond dives. "Now it's my turn" and inserts Walther into barrel, returns fire. Then pumps three more shells into him for good measure. Henchman "metal-mouthed" Jaws next up, magnet drops him into shark pool, but then *he* bites the shark. Meanwhile, Bond rescues Anya, escape in tricked-out pod before British torpedoes demolish "Spider". Jaws swims to next movie...James holds up the British end.

Bond meets the wealthy woman who heads a worldly circus troupe, uncovers that Orlov smuggles priceless Soviet treasures to Khan, replacing them with replicas. Then Khan smuggles real versions into the west via Octopussy's train. Bond finds out that Orlov placed a nuclear warhead aboard one of the train cars, plans to detonate it on US airbase in West Germany, triggering West's disarmament over "accident". Bond pops Orlov, deactivates bomb, returns to India. Assaults Khan's palace with Octopussy and her acrobatic, capable fighters/circus performers. Khan and Lieutenant capture Octopussy, flee in small plane. Bond dives aboard top, pilot Khan flies erratically, executes loop-dee-loops trying to shake Bond. Bond disables right engine, Lieutenant sicced on Bond, he climbs out. Bond whip-antennas him flying. Khan attempts shaky landing, skips along bluff. Bond, Octopussy bail, roll. Khan then freaks, crashes. [Octopussy is portrayed by Maud Adams.]

Jaws falls...he's fine. Captured, escaped, Goodhead and Bond pose as pilots on one of six space shuttles headed for hidden space station. Bond discovers the full plot: destroy humanity with 50 globally-dispersed toxic globes. After Bond and Goodhead recaptured on space station, Bond points out to Jaws his disformity will not be accepted. Jaws beseeches, gets nod from new girl friend, defiantly bashes Drax's men. Bond joins in, disables radar jammer, enabling Marines in their own shuttle to locate station and air-lock an attack. Jaws, Goodhead, Bond thrash away, Marines laser-blast away, Drax runs away, Bond pursues away. Corridor face-off, Drax swoops up laser gun near a fallen, Bond reacts with wrist-gun shot to the chest. "Take a giant step for mankind" and Bond ejects Drax alive into space. Goodhead, Bond pod to Earth.

On waterfront, obstacle, Bond ejects, escapes. In Austria, catches up with Mr. White, who poisoned himself with thallium, dies after training 007 on Franz Oberhauser (Chrisoph Waltz) and beseeching Bond to protect his daughter Madeleine Swann (Lea Seydoux). Bond rescues her from Hinx kidnapping by chasing in plane reduced to a propelled sled. Hinx pursues Bond and Swann on train, bounces Bond around, gets shot by Swann, bounced out by 007. Pair learn of "Nine Eyes", intelligence-sharing network marketed as terrorist savior, but controlled by SPECTRE, instigator of recent attacks, meant to scare countries into enrolling in the security program. Pair sets out after Franz, gets captured. Franz informs pair that his father helped newly orphaned James in youth, psycho admits to killing same father, that he recreated himself to be notorious Ernst Blofeld. About-to-be-probed Bond prods Swann to take his watch, Franz fusses at console. "Doesn't time fly?" Swann slides Bond-activated watch-bomb into goon's huddle, boom! Bond escapes restraints, shoots their way out, whole facility erupts in fireball. Bond, Swann chopper out. Scarred Blofeld choppers in goons, Howitzers Bond at MI-6 HQ. Bond cuts Swann loose from timer-bomb as Ernst Blofeld flies away. M and company gaze in awe as placed charges reduce MI-6 HQ to rubble. Bond and Swann boat away.
